The late W. S. Williams, fath or of Willi- Williams, our photog 1. pher, was born in South Carolina, Feb. 12th 1833 . When very young his parents emigrated to Trnnesee. When 22 years cld, withing to leave the iamily roof, 1. Ieft Tennesce and settled in IFriton then a frontier County, Twe subject of this sketch fr) ved four years in the Confedera te Army, in Co. II 21st Texas Iofantry. At the bombardment of Sabine Pass he with 41 comrades repulsed over 1500 Federals. He was married three times and lost his first wife during the war. Three or four years after the war he moved to Brown Co. and it was there the Indians brutally murdered his wife and two children. Several years after this sad misfor $u$ o he moved to Coke County and settled on what is known as Willicms Ranch. He died in Gail on the morning of 6th Inst. at the age of 72 years having been converted nearly five years before his decease, He left three children to mourn his loss.
