Persths or corporations selling hunting leases are required by law to obtain a shooting license which costs $\$ 5$. . More than four sued each fall.
The preserve record books, which are supplied by the Commission, provide space for the
name and address of the persons hunting, the number of days each spent hunting and the
quantity of game each person quantit
takes.

These records, by law are re-
quired to be forwarded to the quired to be forwarded to the
game commission not later than game commiss.

The Chief Clerk said the principal deterrent heretofore
