

SEC. 2-Any pupil affected with a contagious disease, or from a family so affected, shall be excluded from the school as long as deemed sufficient by the Superintendent, or School Board.

SEC. 2.—Pupils who have failed to prepare their lessons must remain at recesses, or after school, to learn them thoroughly.

SEC. 3.-Pupils on being dismissed in the afternoon must not stay about the building or grounds, and must not loiter on the streets, but proceed immediately home.
