

Vets Questions And Answers

Q — Under what conditions can a peacetime veteran be admitted to a VA hospital for a nonservice-connected disability?

A — Veterans who were discharged or retired for disability incurred or aggravated in line of duty or are receiving compensation or would be eligible to receive compensation except for receipt of retirement pay may be a dimitted for ailments not connected with their service if beds are available.

Q — In the fall, I will be retiring from the Army after 20 years of service. Will I be eligible to go to school under the GI Bill?

À — It will depend upon when you recieve your first unconditional discharge after January 31, 1955. If less than three years have passed since that discharge, you are eligible. If more than three years have passed, you are not. Immediate re-enlistment at the time you received that first unconditional discharge after January 31, 1955, would have had no effect on extending the deadline.

#### Gas Tax Refund Forms Are Due

The Eastland County Farm Bureau has issued a reminder to farmers and ranchers that claims for the federal gas tax refund must be submitted before Sept. 30.

The refund is on the four cents per callon excise tax paid on gasoline and diesel fuel used by sperators on their farms during the period July 1, 1962, to June 30, 1963. New farmers and those who have not received Form 2340 were invited to drop by the Farm Bureau office where a form may be obtained and filled out there.

## County ASCS Offers Payment On Winter Crops

The Eastland County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation office is now offer-ing payment on seeding vetch and winter peas for a winter cover crops, it was announced by Emmett E. Powell, County Office Manager.

Payment rates that will be in effect include the follow-ing: Vetch, 7½ cents per pound; Peas, 3½ cents per pound; 0-20-0, \$1.50 per acre.

The recommended rates are 10 pounds of vetch per acre, 25 pounds of winter peas, and 150 pounds of 0-20-0 or its equi-


