"Browsing With Bev"

During the summer of summer, homemakers look for easy recipes to prepare, so they won't have to spend so much time in a hot kitchen. Here is a cake recipe that will fill the request for something "quick 'n easy", however, this one is good year round. This cake may be baked in two layers or in an oblong baking pan. If baked in two pans, one layer could be frozen and served later, as it would be ready to serve right from the freezer.

LEMON CAKE

- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 1 3-ounce package of lemon jello
- 4 eggs
- 3/4 cup liquid cooking oil
- 3/4 cup water
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice or lemon flavoring

Place the above ingredients in a large bowl and mix thoroughly, by hand or mixer. Pour into baking pan and bake 30-40 minutes at 350 degrees. Makes two nine-inch layers and is best served as a one-layer cake.

Mix powdered sugar and lemon juice until it will spread. You will need about 1/2 cup of this mixture. When the cake is done, spread this mixture over the cake and return to the oven which has been turned off. This is icing for the cake, however the cake is good served without icing.

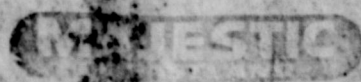

Hints Offered on Peanut Drying

Curing peanuts by artificial means to prevent quality damage requires careful attention to procedure. The proper drying operation is one of the most important factors, points out W. S. Allen, extension agricultural engineer.

If the peanuts are cured too rapidly, their milling quality will be reduced and if the peanuts are exposed to excessively high temperatures, off-flavor may occur, he adds.

Research engineers recommend that the air entering the peanut drying bin not exceed a temperature of 95 degree F with the relative humidity not less than 55 percent. To prevent over drying, only enough heat should be added to the curing air to reduce the relative humidity to a minimum of 55 percent, explains Allen.

The fan should be started, he says, as soon as the air distribution system is uniformly covered with peanuts. Operate the fan continuously and move air up through the peanuts until the moisture content of the kernels in the top layer (six inches) of peanuts is reduced to 10 to 12 percent.

After the moisture is reduced to this level, turn off the heat, but continue to run the fan until all the peanuts are cool. Peanuts cured with heated air will lose about 2 percent kernel moisture to the dry hulls after curing.

Additional information on curing peanuts by artificial means is available from local county agricultural agents, says Allen.
