### County Agricultural Picture Is One Of Brightest In Years

The only poor elements in the overall scene is a very poor peanut crop and a variation in peanut yields due to borer damage and weather. In some other adverse cause.

Nevertheless, an average of about 40 bushels per acre overall is predicted in some quarters and there are parts of the area in which the yield is expected to exceed last year's record average of 49 bushels per acre.

He said that the yields so far noted ranged from 17 bushels per acre to well over 100 bushels, the latter principally from irrigated fields.

He said that the favorable

weather during the growing and harvest season had boosted dry land yields to a better figure, percentage-wise, than yields from irrigated lands.

The harvest was estimated at about 80 per cent complete this week, and given fair weather for the next week most of the crop would be in the dry by the end of the week.

All in all the agricultural picture for the season is expected to boost the county economy by a few millions when the statistics are known. The average peanut crop needs in good condition and livestock prices improving, it is a general agricultural picture in the Eastland County area was one of the brightest in recent years.

If stars are dim there will be rain immediately. Strong perfume from flowers indicate rain. If the sun goes down back of a cloud on Wednesday it will rain before Sunday. There are dozens of other signs of rain too numerous to enumerate, but none came true in 1934.

## Leon-Bosque Resources Plan Faces Congress

The Leon and Bosque Resource Development Project covering Eastland, Comanche, Erath, Somervell and Bosque counties is among 12 projects of the nature recommended by the Soil Conservation Service for approval by the Congress, said a telegram Saturday from Cong. Omar Burleson to the Cisco Press.

The project will be considered for approval by sub-committees of the Senate and House.

my efforts on behalf of this project," Burleson said. The project is aimed at identifying and developing agricultural resources of the 5-county area which would contribute to the economic growth of the area, its sponsors explained.

It would integrate agricultural factors into the overall program for industrial and economic development and aid chamber of commerce and other civic groups in their efforts to attract more industry and stabilize the economic welfare of the region, they said.

### Homemaker's Hints

The artificial sweetener cyclamate, recently was banned by the U. S. Food and Drug Administration. If a product contains cyclamate it will be listed on the label. Food manufacturers are

aligning their products with recommendations stopping the use of the sweetener. Among them is General Foods. In a recent statement, General Foods said they have halted production of foods and

beverages containing cyclamates. Products are Pre-Sweetened Kool-Aid, Soft Drink Mix, Diet Twist Mix, Good Seasons Low calorie Italian Salad Dressing Mix, Log Cabin Light Cal Syrup and Seop Low Calorie Granulated Sugar Replacement.

Conventionally sweetened products will replace them.

Other General Foods lower-calorie foods such as Birds Eye Cool Whip Non-Dairy Whipped Topping and Dream Whip Whipped Topping Mix contain no cyclamates.

The D-Zeta Low Calorie line will be continued until February 1, 1970. Secretary Robert Finch of the Health Education and Welfare Department recognized the need for certain dietary foods for diabetics and others with health problems.

The company plans to reformulate the products to contain no cyclamates.

The concern about cyclamates is not sudden. But it is alarming! For one thing, use of the sweetener was booming; U. S. consumption had increased six times in the last seven years.

Nearly 70 percent of this would be in soft drinks.

**AN ORDINANCE**  
AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND DETERMINING THE GENERAL SERVICE RATE TO BE CHARGED FOR SALES OF NATURAL GAS TO RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CONSUMERS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF CARBON, EASTLAND COUNTY TEXAS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER IN WHICH SUCH RATE MAY BE CHANGED, ADJUSTED AND AMENDED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CARBON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Effective with the first gas bills rendered after the final approval of this ordinance, the maximum general service rate for sales of natural gas rendered to residential and commercial consumers within the city limits of Carbon by Lone Star Gas Company, a Texas corporation, its successors and assigns, is hereby fixed and determined as follows:

- First 2,000 cu. ft. or less \$1.344 per Mcf Gross; \$1.21 per Mcf Net.
- Next 10,000 cu. ft. @ \$1.11 per Mcf Gross; \$.91 per Mcf Net.
- Next 10,000 cu. ft. @ .900 per Mcf Gross; .81 per Mcf Net.
- All Over 22,000 cu. ft. @ .789 per Mcf Gross; .71 per Mcf Net.

MINIMUM BILL — \$2.688 Gross; \$2.42 Net per meter per month.

#### ADJUSTMENT

The amount of each net monthly bill, computed at the above stated rates shall be subject to the following adjustment: Plus an amount equivalent to the proportionate part of any new tax, or increased tax, or any other governmental imposition, rental, or charge (except state, county, city and special district ad valorem taxes and taxes on net income) levied, assessed or imposed subsequent to July 1, 1969, upon or allocable to the Company's distribution operations, by any new or amended law, ordinance or contract. Each gross monthly bill shall be adjusted proportionately. Company, at its option, may forego the application of this adjustment; however, failure of Company to apply such adjustment shall not constitute a waiver of Company's right from time to time, or at any time, to make such adjustment, in whole or in part, in any subsequent current monthly bill that may be applicable to such bill.

Net rates shall apply to all bills paid within ten days from monthly billing date; gross rate shall be applicable thereafter.

The above rate is applicable to each residential and commercial consumer per month or for any part of a month for which gas is used at the same location.

In addition to the aforesaid rates, Company shall have the right to collect such reasonable charges as are necessary to conduct its business and to carry out its reasonable rules and regulations in effect.

SECTION 2. The rate set forth in Section 1 may be changed and amended by either the City or Company furnishing gas in the manner provided by law. Service hereunder is subject to the orders of regulatory bodies having jurisdiction, and to the Company's Rules and Regulations currently on file in the Company's office.

SECTION 3. The fact that there is an imperative public need for an ordinance fixing and determining the rate for gas and gas service furnished to residential and commercial consumers creates an emergency, and the reading and passage of this ordinance at three separate meetings is hereby suspended and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage at a single meeting and the approval thereof by the Mayor.

Passed and approved on this the 3rd day of December, A. D. 1969.
