### October 15th Will Be Effective Date

The Texas National Guard's 49th Division, of which the Cisco Unit is a part, has been ordered to move to Fort Hood, Texas, as a part of the U.S. Army's reorganization according to reports from Washington, D. C., today. It is understood that the effective date of the assignment would be October 15.

The assignment was expected to be explained in detail by Postmaster officials later in the day. Some time ago, it was indicated that the 49th Division might be a regular Army unit in the event it was called up.

The Cisco unit - Battery C, 3rd Reconnaissance Battalion, 132nd Artillery, 49th Division - includes more than 50 officers and men. The commanding officer is First Lieutenant Winford H. Hogan of Clyde, a teacher and coach of the school system there.

The unit includes young men from throughout this region as well as a number of collegians who drive here for the regular weekend drills.

It was believed that the unit's first few weeks of active duty would be at the local armory while the vast amount of paper work and some refresher training are carried out.

Sergeant James O. Hendrick, administrative officer of the Cisco unit, told The Press that his office had no information from official sources. He had heard about the announcement to the press in Washington.

The 49th division was notified about Sept. 1 that it had been named a "priority" unit for preparedness in the wake of unsteady conditions in Berlin. This status was an indication that the division would be given intensified training to assure a peak of efficiency for possible call into active Army service. At that time the division was authorized to recruit some 4,500 men with prior military service. Otis Ray Jordan and Bob Hogan two local boys who are in the 49th Division.

### EASTLAND COUNTY TO GIVE PEANUTS FOR CROP PROGRAM

Sunday, Sept. 17th and Sunday, Sept. 24th, have been designated as CROP Sundays. Each minister in Eastland County is asked to use one of these two Sundays to speak a few minutes about CROP. CROP is, of course, the Christian Rural Overseas Program and listed are some facts that will help explain the program.

CROP is the community food and self-help appeal of the churches, national, state and local.

CROP is a program of Church World Service, the overseas relief and rehabilitation agency of 35 Protestant and Eastern Orthodox communions. State councils of churches sponsor CROP in their states.

Many farm and community organizations, service agencies, producers and processors cooperate with the CROP appeal and render invaluable service.

CROP food is distributed overseas through the existing facilities of the churches.

Eastland County will contribute peanuts to CROP. These peanuts will be made into peanut butter and sent overseas to the hungry of the world.

The program works in this way. When a farmer harvests his crop of peanuts, he will donate as many bags as he desires of peanuts for the CROP program. These peanuts will be brought to a warehouse and kept until the program is complete. They will then be shelled by the Gorman Peanut Company and sent to a processing plant. Finally, they will be shipped overseas as peanut butter.

### County Receives State Fund For Road Improvement

County Judge John Hart recently received a check for \$30,828.59 representing the return to the county as its part from the revenue taken in by a one-cent state gasoline tax. The money will be divided among the four Eastland County precincts for road improvements and upkeep.

The tax is collected to retire outstanding Road District Bonds that were assumed by the Board of County Bond Indebtedness several years ago.

Eastland County would have collected more if it had not had the outstanding bonds. A total of \$1,369.45 was applied to the county's indebtedness.

## Drivers License Fees To Increase

Austin — The Texas Department of Public Safety reminded Texas drivers today an increase in license fees has been ordered by the Legislature effective September 1.

The Texas Operator's license on and after that date will be increased from \$2 to \$3 for a two-year period, the commercial driver's license will be increased from \$3 to \$4.50 for a three-year period, and the chauffeur's license will go up from \$4 to \$6 per year.

The fee for a duplicate of lost license will remain at 25 cents.

"We urge all drivers to be sure they send the right amount in with their renewal applications," said Col. Homer Garrison, Jr., DPS Director. "Those which are accompanied by the old fee after September 1 will have to be returned to the sender, causing unnecessary delay and inconvenience."

He said the \$3 two-year operator's license will still be lower than the fees in 12 other states and will be exactly the same as in five other states. He reported Texas now has 4,838,000 currently licensed drivers.

"Incidentally," said Garrison, "we would like to urge drivers to take care of their licenses, in spite of the fact that it only costs 25 cents for a replacement. Last year we received 85,000 applications for duplicates of lost or mutilated licenses."

**School Consolidation Move Opposed By Eastland Board**

The board of trustees of the District went on record Monday as opposed to the proposed county school consolidation program.

A statement signed by Supt. Wendell T. Siebert of the Eastland schools was issued as follows:

"The Eastland Independent School District board of trustees, meeting in regular session on September 11, 1961, voted unanimously to publicly declare that they have not and do not at this time endorse the proposal of a consolidated high school for Eastland County.

"It is the feeling of the group that such a move would not be economical and that the needs of the high school students of Eastland would not be more adequately met by such a move." The consolidation proposal has been under consideration and discussion in the county for the past year. Special legislation was approved by the Texas Legislature last spring to provide financial aid to those schools entering into consolidation.

A committee of citizens has been studying a proposal for consolidation of the schools of Eastland, Ranger and Olden for several months.

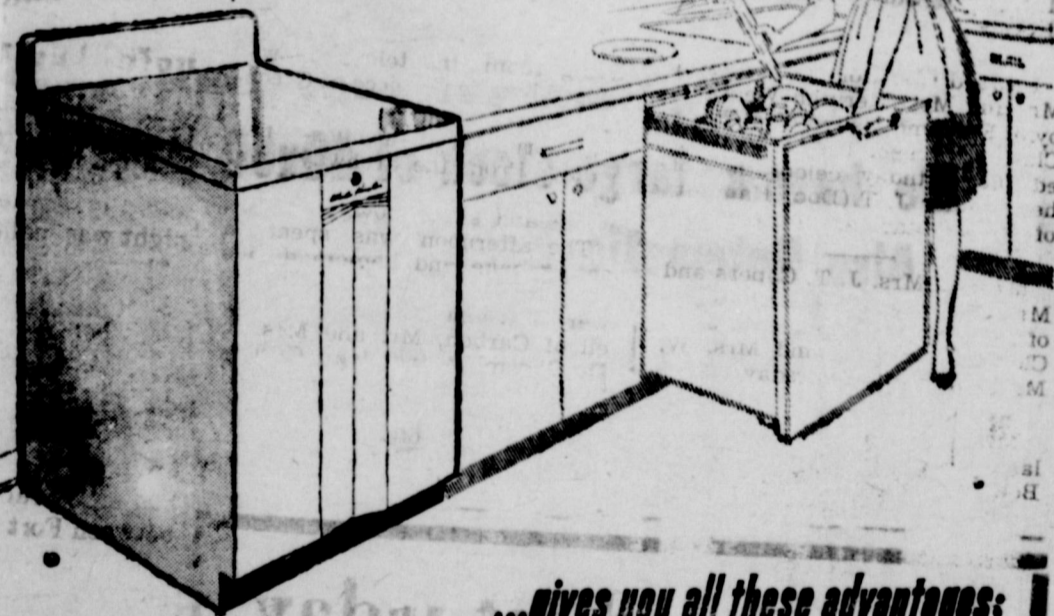
