## Cowgirls Win First In DC Invitational


The Cowgirls defeated Andrews in straight games last Saturday to become the Champions of the 1989 Fillie Invitational Volleyball Tournament.

Falling behind 6-11 in the first game, the Cowgirls rallied to a 15-13 win and took game two with a 15-8 score. Cowgirl hitting included Marsha Farnham, eight kills; Leslie Patton, four kills; Melissa Green, two kills; Rena McElroy, two kills; and Sandra Ramos, one kill. Leslie led all servers with nine points. Sandra and Martha Rivera recorded five digs each defensively and Marsha and Rena combined for five blocks.


The Cowgirl defense toppled Denver City 15-6 15-10 in semifinal action with Rena posting seven blocks and Martha four digs. Melissa contributed eight service points and Leslie, Martha and Rena put down three kills each.

### **NOTICE TO CITY UTILITY CUSTOMERS**

The City Council voted at a special meeting held August 15, 1989, to increase all sewer and garbage rates \$1.00. For example, residential sewer rates have been \$7.00 and will now be \$8.00 and residential garbage rates have been \$8.00 (\$8.56 with state tax) and will now be \$9.00 (\$9.63 with state tax). These new rates will become effective September 1, 1989, and will not be reflected on your utility bill until the end of September. It is the desire of the City Council to keep rates as low as possible, but new laws making many changes for the operation of sewer lift stations and sanitary landfills make it necessary for these increases.








Each child was given a name tag and everyone was encouraged to get acquainted.
