

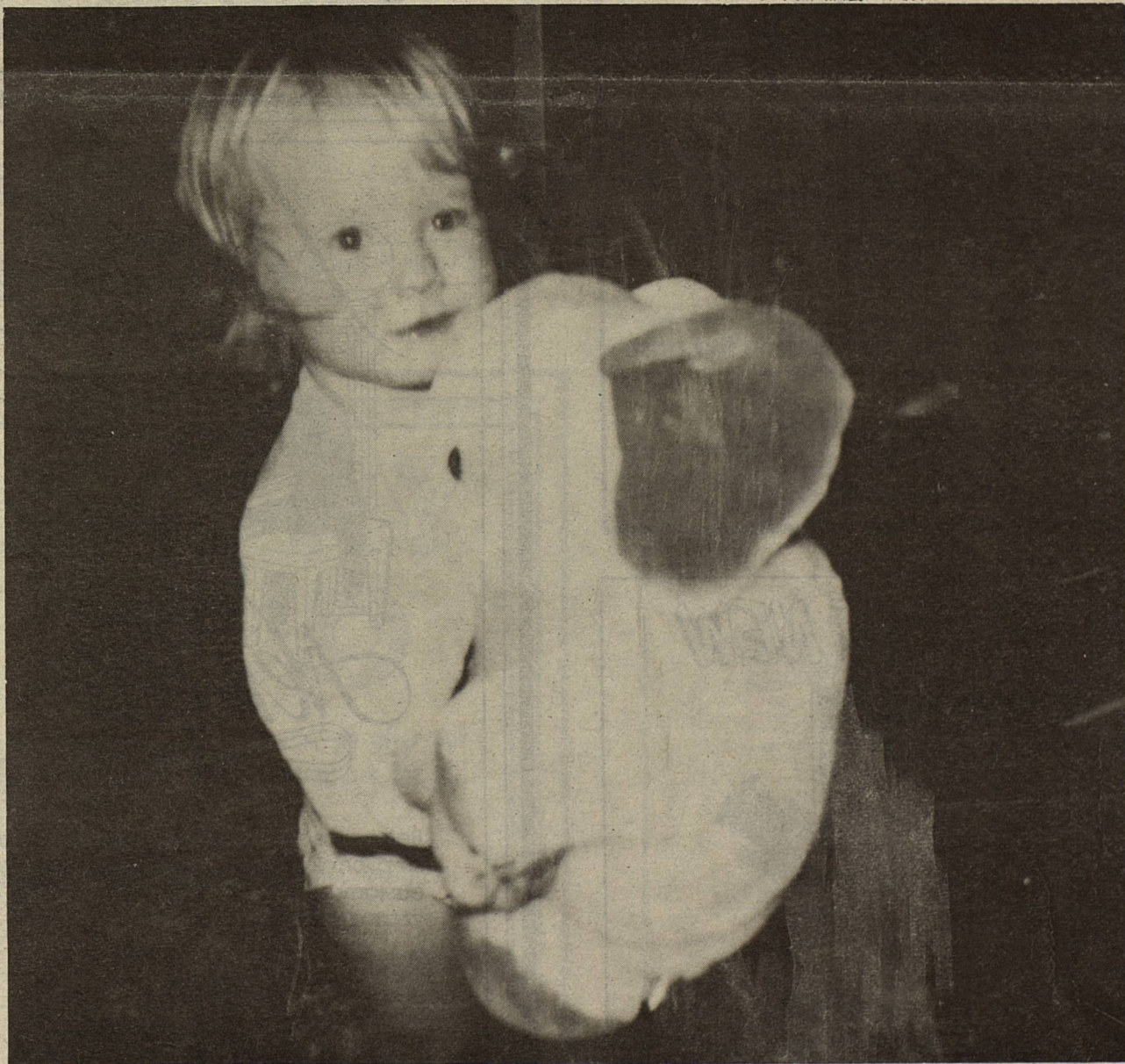

I hope 1990 is a very prosperous and positive year for you.

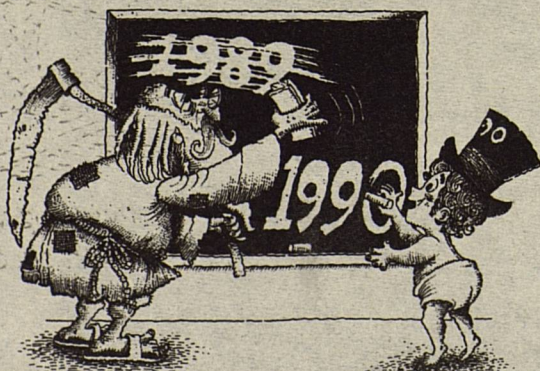

Electricity is Helpful **DON'T**



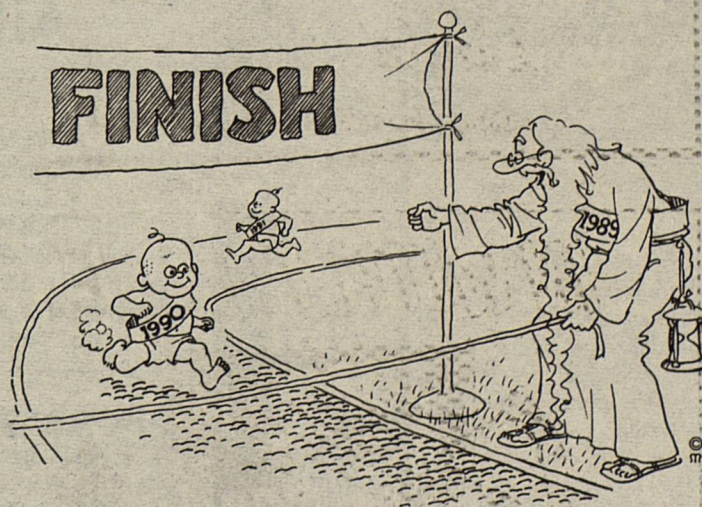
DON'T MAKE IT HAZARDOUS!

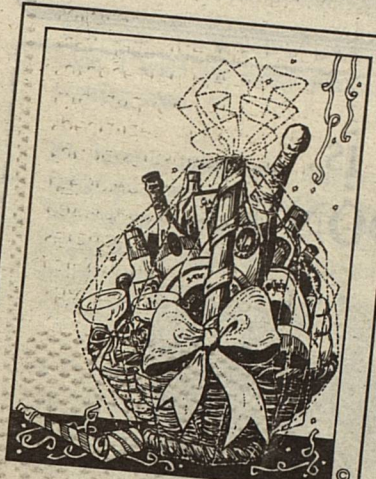
