

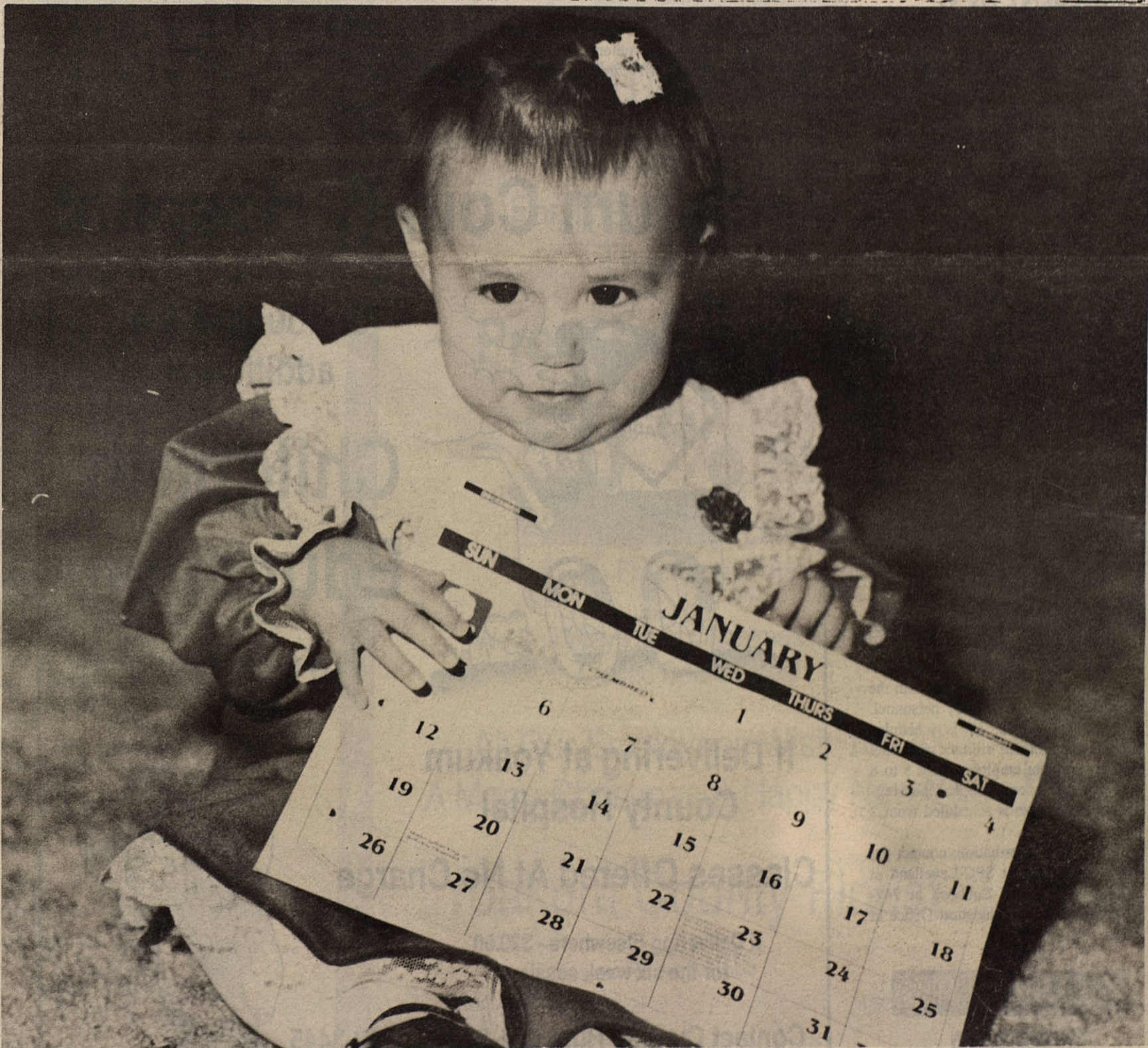

Spring Registration Slated At SPC

Spring registration at South Plains College begins Jan. 7-8 on the SPC Lubbock campus, located at 1302 Main.
