 uncertain in mass murder mmamisSAN YSIDRO, Calif. - A man who told his wife, "I'll see you later," and then walked into a McDonald's restaurant and shot to death 21 people and wounded 19 more in just 10 minutes may have
been despondent over being fired as a security guard last week, police said Thursday.
But officials said they still had no notive for the Wednesday afternoon
slaughter by James Oliver Huberty, 41, who was slain by a police sharpshooter more than an hour after he opened up with a pistol, shotgun and rifle. It was believed to be the largest one-day mass
murder by a gunman in U.S. history. nurder by a gunman in U.S. history.
Huberty was described as a survivalist who expected "the end of the world," a man who was "always mad at
