designed to prevent blacks from
voting and laws protecting racially
based restrictive covenants in proper-
ty deeds. It was the ACLU that fought
censorship of James Joyce's Ulysses;
it was the ACLU that defended John
Scopes in the infamous "Monkey
Trial" of 1925.
