Course Planned For Parents Of Deaf Children

A special summer school course has been planned by the Texas School for the Deaf in Austin for parents of pre-school deaf children, according to an announcement here Saturday. The announcement read as follows:

"Parents of deaf children have an extra ordinary problem in that medical, psychological and educational counseling is needed if they are to be enabled to fit more successfully in the parental role of helping the child develop his readiness for school and something of what may be expected in the way of development in the child's educational experience.

"The Texas School for the Deaf is offering a five day course for both parents (who understand and speak English) of Texas children between the ages of 18 months and 8 years, if the children have not attended school, from June 5-11, 1955.

"The only expense is that of transportation to and from Austin. "A deaf child now five, but who

Patrol Inspector Positions Open

JAY WILLIAMS WILL MANAGE LAKE CISCO SWIMMING POOL

Jay Williams, head coach at Cisco High School, has been named manager of the Lake Cisco Swimming Pool for the coming season, according to an announcement this week. Plans call for the pool to open about May 1.

The Lake Cisco pool and skating rink operate under the Butts Post 123 of the American auspices of the John William Legion. The skating rink runs the year around and is being managed by I.D. Reynolds. The Lake Cisco miniature golf course, operated by Ed Wende, opened recently.

Mr. Williams will be in complete charge of the pool and will have the pool concession, the announcement said. He is expected to begin preparation for the coming season around April 15.

To accommodate many high school classes from throughout West Texas, who come here each year for annual outings, the Lake Cisco Pool opens about May 1 each year. A number of schools

have already written that they plan to be here for outings.

Announcement concerning the summer swimming season will be made by Mr. Williams later in the month. The pool was managed the past two summers by W. P. Knight, who recently joined the street department of the City of Austin as a map maker.

Mr. Williams is a native of this area and has been in the school system for several years. He is a veteran of World War II, is a Reservist in the National Guard unit here, and is a member of the local Legion Post.

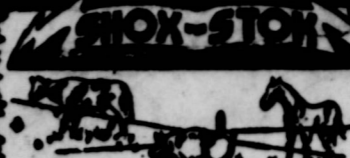

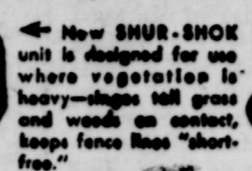

Eastland County Back On Drought Emergency List

Eastland County is one of several West Texas counties designated to receive benefits under the Drought Emergency Feed Program until May 15, according to information today by Congressman Omar Burleson.

The county feed program, which has been administered under the direction of Supervisor George I. Lane of the Farm Home Administration, will operate in the same manner as in the past. The county received drought relief feed from August 15, 1954, to February 15, 1955.

Due to the extreme spring drought, the program was reopened in 82 Central and West Texas counties. Only feed grains are available under the program.

Milk Minimum Price Is Set By Market Agency

Producers supplying milk for the Central West Texas market (23 cities in Central West Texas) are to receive a minimum price of \$5.47 per hundredweight for milk sold during March, Byford W. Bain, Market Administrator, announced. This price applies to milk delivered to plants at Abilene, San Angelo, Stamford, and Sweetwater. For milk delivered to plants at Midland and Lamesa a price 15 cents higher is paid.

The supply of feed will be limited to 30 days and all applications must be filed by April 29, the county office said.

In the program, livestock owners receive credit for freight charges.

and for milk delivered to Brownwood Mineral Wells prices 20 and 25 cents lower, respectively, is paid. For each point (0.1%) that the average butterfat content varies from 4.0%, a butterfat differential of 6.9 cents applies.

This price was computed from reports filed by eleven milk handlers regulated by the Central West Texas milk marketing order.

In March an average of 372,439 pounds (almost 175,000 quarts) of Class I milk (milk, skim milk, buttermilk, chocolate milk, and cream) was sold each day by these eleven handlers. This was an increase of 4.9% from March 1954.

Milk was supplied to the Central West Texas market in March by 712 producers who supplied an average of 407,946 pounds of milk each day. This is the largest volume of milk supplied for the mar-

ket in the last 28 months. It was 2.6% larger than a year ago. However, supplies were less in relation to Class I sales in March this year than in March last year because of the increase in Class I sales.
