

Quail Harvest Due To Be Slim

AUSTIN, Nov. 21. - The com-ing quail harvest in Texas promises lean shooting generally but the Director of Wildlife Restoration for the Game and Fish Commission hopes for an improved proportional return on quail wings for research.

This program, he said, has been marked by increased cooperation by hunters in recent years. This fall it becomes more than ever because efforts to scientifically appraise quail population variations. The quail season under the General Law runs from December 1 through January 16 but there are special seasons in several The Director of Wildlife Restoration asked hunters in areas where quail stocks permit some harvest to write the Commission headquarters in Austin for special containers for quail wings, as well as general instructions.
