Patrolman Rivers said, "All men between the ages of 20 and 35 who are of sound physical condition, have at least a high school education or equivalent, have vision of not less than 20-40 and have high moral standards should contact him or any member of the Texas Department of Public Safety immediately.

There are four branches of service for which men are directly recruited-Driver License, License and Weight, Highway Patrol and Motor Vehicle Inspection. Trainees are assigned to the service for which they are best suit-

Upon graduation from the 18 week training program at the modern DPS Law Enforcement Academy in Austin, thetrainee is commissioned into one of these services. At the Academy, he will receive a salary of \$500 a month while in training. He will be taught such subjects as Texas Highway Law, accident investigation, first aid, profession'l driving, care and use of firearms, and many other subjects. The next class begins

'FRIENDLY SITTERS' ARE WELCOME

"Friendly Sitter" is a new columteer service being develmented elderly.

With the help of Mobile res-With the help of Mobile residents Friendly Sitters has recruited. The service is limited at present but it can grow as the need develops.

These volunteers are "on call" to sit with anyone who cannot be left alone so that the person responsible can get away for a few hours to take care of pressing personal or emergency service it is free except for transportation. If the client cannot arrange to pick up and return the volunteer, he must pay cab fare to and from his home. The services of the volunteer sitters provided through the new program of the Adult Services Council cannot be provided free except on an emergency basis. Any arrangement for regularly scheduled visits, whether free or paid for, must be made between the client

The following guide lines have been developed for the protection both of the volunteer Sitters and those they serve:

1. The sitters are not nurses, and cannot be expected to assume responsibility for a critically ill person; nor are they maids and cannot be expected to give more than companionship and protection. This would include small personal services and when absolutely necessary, giving simple medications provided the client gives explicit directions befroe leaving. Not even the simplest medication should be given at the request of the one being sat with.

2. The Sitter must be given a briefing by the client on the condition, capabilities and neds of her charge. Telephone numbers must be available where the client or other responsible persons can be reached if an emergency develop.
