COLQUITT CUTS 3,500- 000 FROM BUDGET

Half Million Cut from A. & M.
Appropriation Comptrollers
Department Suffers.

Austin, Aug. 23.—A veto of appropriations totaling at least \$3,500,000 to avoid a tax increase of 15 cents is the situation that will confront the people of the State today when the Governor's appropriation vetoes are made public. The farmers of the State in session at College Station, through a delegation, apprised the Governor of their willingness to pay an increased tax rate if their institutions were properly supported. Other delegations have called on the Executive in behalf of their own institutions. It was availed nothing. The Governor's blue pencil has only marked a deeper, broader line.

Comptroller Lane visited the Executive office yesterday afternoon at the request of the Governor to discuss the State tax rate for the coming two years and arrange figures to be submitted to the board when it meets at a called session this morning.

In discussing with Mr. Lane the amount, or the approximate amount, to be considered, the Governor stated that it would be between \$11,000,000 and \$12,000,000, more nearly at the half way mark. This makes a cut in the appropriations of \$3,500,000, as the free conference committee report as submitted to the Governor, carried a total appropriation for all purposes of \$15,068,000.

HANDS OFF SAYS OUR UNCLE SAM

President Wilson Sends Warning
to Mexicans. Americans Must
Not Be Harmed.

Washington, Aug. 22.—Curt warning to both the Huerta and constitutionalist commanders at La Boquilla, Chihuahua, Mexico, that the United States will hold them personally responsible for any violence against Americans by "any one claiming military or civil authority," was sent today by Secretary Bryan through American Consul Letcher at Chihuahua City.

Secretary Bryan instructed Mr. Letcher to dispatch his message to La Boquilla by courier and secure an answer. His action was in response to a request by Senator Penrose for protection for H. C. Hulse, Chief Engineer Fuller and other Americans at the plant of the Mexican Northern Power and Irrigation company.

Secretary Bryan's telegram follows:

"Information having been received by this government that threats of violence and death have been made against Hulse, Fuller and others at La Boquilla, this government deems it proper to say that if any violence is visited upon any American citizen there or elsewhere, by any one claiming civil or military authority, the United States will hold responsible the perpetrators there of.

"Couriers should ascertain conditions of all foreigners at La Boquilla and report with reply of the officer in charge to this government's message."

The reference to the protection of American citizens, "elsewhere" was taken as indicative of the United States in protection of Americans wherever their safety is threatened.

THAW'S CHAUFFER THREATENS TO SQUEAL

Man Who Drove Car For Thaw
Says He May Tell of
Conspiracy.

Sherbrooke, Quebec, Aug. 22.—"Gentleman Roger" Thompson, the New York chauffeur held under the domination immigration laws as having aided Harry Thaw legally a lunatic, to cross the Canadian frontier, announced from his cell tonight that he was "up against it" and that if the Thaw family did not come to his relief he would perhaps, in justice to himself, be forced to tell all he knows about Thaw's escape from Matteawan and thus complicate the proceedings under which Thaw's lawyers hope to obtain his release on a writ of habeas corpus next Wednesday.

Tonight Thompson removed the smoked eye glasses he has worn since his arrest and openly admitted that the name "Mitchel Thompson" he had given the authorities was fictitious and that in reality he is Roger Thompson, car salesman and daredevil chauffeur, who drove the black machine which whisked Stanford White's slayer away from Matteawan.

"Sure I'm Roger Thompson," he said. "I need money and help now and it is up to the Thaws. I was 'framed up' in getting in this case and they ought to stand by me. I haven't a cent. I would be arrested if I crossed the New York state line. It's rough stuff. The other four fellows mixed up in the game made their get away. But I stuck to Thaw to the finish and I'm the goat."

"What about the details of the escape?" he was asked.

"Don't ask me," said Thompson. "I can't talk about that now."

Thaw in a cell above "Gentleman Roger" refused even to admit he had ever saw him.

"That man," he exclaimed, "you know I can't talk about him."

Counsel has been employed for Thompson by the Thaw family and it was through their efforts that his arraignment today as a violator of the immigration laws was postponed until Friday next. His lawyer is Louis St. Laurent of Quebec. It was admitted by the chauffeur that "the Thaws" had retained St. Laurent and that they expected him (Thompson) to keep "his trap shut". He added grimly that he thought they ought to do more than give him a lawyer.

Thaw had a quarrel with his many attorneys today. They had warned him to issue no statements but he insisted on talking about what he described as an omission on the part of the newspapers in Canada and the United States in not printing in full a statement of his lawyers quoting Mr. Travers Jerome as saying Thaw was sane.

"This omission has outraged the British idea of fair play," said Thaw. As he spoke he bit his nail to the quick and rumbled up a pile of letters and telegrams on the pine table in his cell. On the window sill stood a bouquet of wild flowers sent him by an anonymous woman sympathizer.

DOGS EAT BODY OF ABANDONED BABY

Two Dead Babies Found in Brown
wood in Two Days. Two Ar-
rest Made.

Brownwood, Aug. 23.—Another dastardly crime came to light today when the body of a well developed white girl baby was dragged into an orchard on Henley street by a bull dog, which had evidently been eating on the body. The head was gone and the upper part of the body was considerably mutilated, as though the dog had endeavored to eat the child after finding it. The body was intact from the abdomen down.

Sheriff Denman and District Attorney Walter Early were summoned and an investigation was immediately begun. Fragments of the skull were found nearby, and following the trail the officers discovered in an alley, nearby part of a shoe box in which the child had been placed. The box was torn and bloodstained, and a bloodstained cloth was found nearby indicating that the child had been wrapped in the cloth, placed in the box, and then left to its fate in a little clump of bushes near the end of the alley. Pieces of the skull was scattered hairs, were found on the box, showing that the dog had discovered it there and started in to tear the little body to pieces while it was yet in the box.

It has been decided that the child was left in the alley Tuesday or Wednesday night, and the dogs have visited the place and eaten the body at various times before it was dragged from

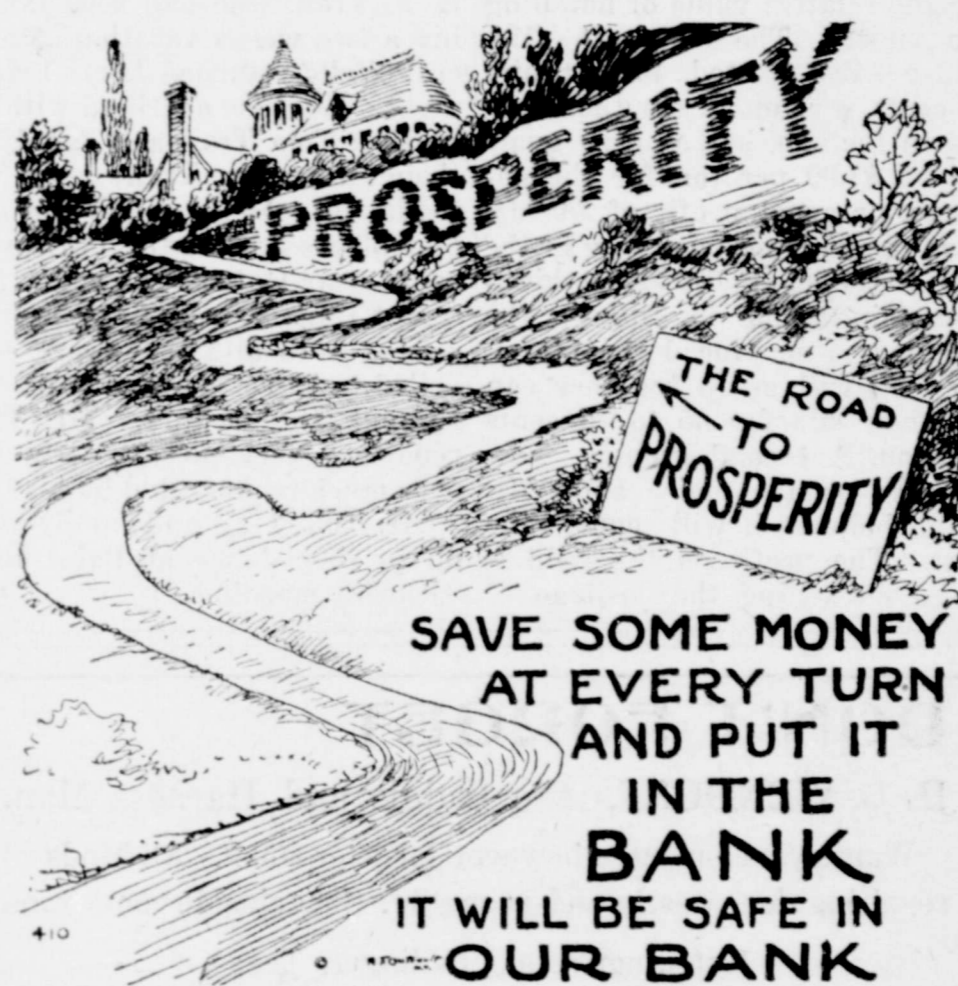
BIG IRRIGATION PROJECT LOOMING UP

Current Rumor Says Deal for Dam
Site Reservoir Has Been Clos-
ed and Actual Work to
Begin SOON.

We have been unable to get anything reliable or direct from headquarters, or to learn where headquarters are located, but we do know that somebody is spending a young fortune towards a starting point for the big irrigation project that has been so much talked of during the last year.

It is a well known fact that men representing millions of dollars visited this place and made a thorough inspection of the proposed location for the big dam and lake and also went over the proposed irrigation district, and they left a proposition here that had a business "ring" to it, and they returned to the land from whence they came. A short time after this, men appeared on the ground where this great lake will be when the dam is built, and began to thump around and put down test wells, to see what kind of a foundation they could find. Engineers also appeared on the scene and have been busy running lines from every point of the compass. Surveyors have been at work thru the territory extending from the proposed dam site to the Concho river, running lines through the county near Rowena and also a survey has been made three miles North of Miles. This is supposed to be for the purpose of locating the right-of-way for the big ditch, which when completed will feed the flumes that will furnish the necessary liquid to the farmers

SOME FACTS ABOUT IRRIGATION.

No year in the entire history of the country has been better suited to a test of what irrigation means to this country than the present year. The rainfall has been entirely inadequate for the crops and only where land was overflowed along the creeks or the crops watered in some way have the crops made anything like a fair yield.

Mr. Miller bought this farm with the idea of flooding the land at least once during each year, believing that even with that amount of irrigation he can raise good crops every year, and thus carrying out our contention that if the farmers who own land in this country will ditch the surplus water that now falls on their pasture land so it will run on the farm land they will receive great benefit.

\$7.00 per ton. It will likely sell for \$10.00 and in that case the net profit will be increased very much. The point of this article is that if the farmer in this country can manage to get his land really wet once each year that he is sure of a crop. The second point of suggestion being that there is more hard cash in raising feed than cotton. Col. J. H. Parramore, who grows this country as well, perhaps better than most men, claim that every man, who can, should have at least 10 acres or irrigated land, and that it should be planted in maize or sorghum or some feed of that variety and that it should be cut green and then be fed to stock by the farmer himself who would reap the benefit of his labor.

Irrigation will do the work and as we see the matter it is up to the people who can irrigate to do so, and those whose land is not located so that it can be irrigated should dam their field in, so to speak and ditch every drop of water that falls on their pastures to the farm land. In this movement the business men in town must stand shoulder to shoulder with the business man on the farm and by doing this the future growth of the country is assured.

and will enable them to produce thousands of dollars of produce, where at present they are cultivating a bed of dust, and renewing mortgages from year to year. Fifteen men are at work today on making the survey for this big canal, and it is rumored in Ballinger that the deal for thirteen thousand acres of land has been closed. This land is located three miles from Bronte and is said to be the most natural place for building a dam and impounding water there is in the United States, capacity considered. The natural advantage for controlling this water after it has been impounded is also said to make it the most favorable proposition of the kind anywhere to be found. Expert engineers, and men with experience in such matters, say that at least seventy-five thousand acres of fertile land can be irrigated by gravitation on the South side of the river, and while no survey has been made on the North side of the river below the proposed dam site, it is claimed that the land owners will take advantage of it as soon as the proposition is put up to them.

We have been reliably informed that an English syndicate is behind this great project, and that the millions of dollars that it will require to put the great plant in operation is a small matter with them—only a "drap in the buck et." They are men no doubt who have made their money by taking advantage of just such opportuni-

ties as this great Colorado River irrigation project offers. They will get returns on their money by selling the water to the farmers within reach of their big canal, and it is a certainty that every farmer along that ditch will want the water turned down his cotton row when the crop is in the stage where a good wetting will bring him a big crop, and to miss the water means a failure for him.

We made the prediction, when this move was put on foot that the great project would be put through, but we thought it would require much longer time to perfect it than now seems probable. The rapid progress that is being made on the work is perhaps due to the drouth that prevails and the short crops resulting. If the season had been more favorable for crop growing and a big cotton crop had been raised in the proposed irrigation district there is no doubt but what the work would not have received the encouragement and financial aid necessary to make it a success. The work is making much better headway than the most optimistic hoped for, and it is our opinion that in the near future there will be a demand for laborers on this work.
