HANG TEXAS RANCHER

| Larede, Tex., Feb. 25.-The ranching country along this portion of the Texas border was wait ing tonight in suppressed exciteanent for the details of the hanging of Clemente Vergara, an American citizen and Texas ranchman, by Mexican Federals, which was officially confirmed in messages to Consul Garrett, at Nuevo Laredo today. <br> Consul Garrett immediately left for Hidalgo, near where Vergara's mody was said to have been left at the place of execution to arrange for its proper disposal and to begin an investigation of the case.
