## TAXES COVER

LONDON, Aug. 3.---Stockholm reports that the Russian and German fleets met today.

A large Russian vessel, according to the report, was driven ashore by the German ships.

It was also reported that a naval battle ensued today between the German and British squadrons in the North Sea. Six German warships were sunk according to the message received here.

Two British vessels also were sunk in the fight.

The British admiralty has no confirmation of the report but admit that the British destroyers were scouting there and located the Germany vessels Sunday night.

The Russian fleet was found by the German squadron and attacked under cover during the night. The Russians fled to the Finland Sea with the'exception of the large one which was sunk.

## Ifaly Is Mobilizing

ROME, Aug. 3.---Italy today ordered a complete mobilization of her army.

She still insists that the order was merely for protection and stated she intended to remain nfutral.
