
A - No. Since your veteran-parent died after you had passed age 18, you will have five years from the date of his death in which to complete your War Orphans schooling.

Q - There has just been a new addition to our family, a baby boy. I am at school under the Korean GI Bill, and I know this entitles me to an increase in my allowance money, but what do I have to send VA as proof of my

A - To support your claim of additional allowance money, send VA either a certified copy of the public record of birth, or a certi-fied copy of the church record of the child's baptism.
