economical return, must be protected from the elements and
have a continuous have a continuous supply of or-
ganic material for maintainin ganic material for maintaining
soil tilth. Winter cover crops ful fill these two needs.
On the sandy land rye is pri-
marily used for protection from marily used for protection from wind erosion. Vetch is used in
combination with rye to add nitrogen and provide a higher quality of organic material for
returning to the land. Vetch and returning to the land. Vetch and
rye has been a great help in
maintaing maintaining peanut yields in the
area since vetch area since vetch was introduce
here on a large scale some twelv to fourteen years ago.
While Vetch has been mos popular on sandy land it does
give good results on the heiver give good results on the heavier
