# Turks Fire on U. S. Launch. 

## Sailors From Cruiser Tennessee Shelled in Aegean Sea By Batteries



WASHINGTON, Nov. 19.---A launch from the cruiser Tennessee was fired upon by Turkish land batteries while it was en route from Vurlah to Smyrna, reported Captain Decker to the navy department today. Secretary Daniels of the navy department immediately asked for further particulars.
In the meanwnile, he insisted there is no cause of alarm.
Ambassador Mergenthau notified the Tennessee to leave Vurlah, and shortly after receiving the orders Captain Decker steamed for Chios, a Grecian possession in the Aegean Sea.
