## NATIONAL AND STATE PEANUT ALLOTMENTS ARE SET FOR 1958

### County Votes To Spend \$5,000 On Ranger Hospital

The Eastland County Commissioners' Court voted to spend approximately \$5,000 on repairs for the Ranger General Hospital at their meeting last Tuesday. This action came after County Attorney Joe Nuessle reported that they had full authority to invest money in repairing the hospital.

Ranger General Hospital is jointly operated by the City of Ranger and the county. Each appoints half the members of the governing board and shares the operating costs.

In his report, Nuessle stated that both he and the state attorney general agreed that the county could invest money out of the county permanent improvement fund for hospital repairs, although the county has only half interest in the hospital. Nuessle also recommended that the county ask and receive a budget from the hospital board each year.

### Improvements Are Planned On Two County Highways

The Texas Highway Department will spend \$333,000 for improvements on farm-to-market roads in Eastland County during 1958, according to an announcement by District Engineer Robert J. Milligan of Brownwood. This will be in addition to the regular program.

The State Highway Commission recently approved this appropriation to improve existing farm roads, Mr. Milligan said. The improvements will include shoulder widening, seal coating, additional surfacing and for widening of structures and roads.

The two county projects will be supervised by Gordon Smith, resident engineer, and personnel of the county office. Plans call for the program to begin by spring.

Funds allotted for Eastland County will be spent on the following projects:

Farm Road 3 will be repaired from the junction of Highway 6 in Gorman east to the Erath County line. Work will include reconstruction of grading, structures and surface.

Farm Road 717 from the Stephens County line south to Farm Road 101 in Ranger will be reconditioned and resurfaced and structures will be widened.

A national allotment of 1,610,000 acres of 1958-crop peanuts for picking and threshing and a marketing quota of 826,000 tons have been announced by Acting Secretary of Agriculture True D. Morse. Both the marketing quota and the national acreage allotment for the 1958-crop are at the levels required by law. The Texas Allotment for 1958 is 355,955 acres.

Legislation provides that the marketing quota must be equal to the average quantity of peanuts harvested for nuts during the five years immediately preceding the year in which the quota is proclaimed, adjusted for current trends and prospective demand conditions; but the quota must be not less than a quantity sufficient to provide a national acreage allotment of at least 1,610,000 acres.

In determining the marketing quota for the 1958 crop, a "normal" yield of 1,026 pounds per acre was used. This yield, multiplied by 1,610,000 acres, the minimum national acreage allotment, results in the national marketing quota of 826,000 tons. If the minimum national allotment provision of the law were not in effect, the national marketing quota would be 675,000 tons which with allowance for under harvesting would result in a national acreage allotment of 1,446,000 acres.

In a referendum on December 11, 1956, peanut farmers approved marketing quotas and they are in effect for the crops to be produced in 1957, 1958 and 1959. Price support will be available at a level between 75 and 90 percent of parity in 1958 and in 1959 depending upon the supply at the beginning of the marketing year (August 1). Marketing quotas for peanuts since 1949.

The 1958 national acreage allotment, less one-fourth of 1 percent reserved for a new farms, is apportioned to States in accordance with the provisions of the Agricultural Adjustment Act of 1938, as amended. The acreage allotment for each state will be apportioned among individual peanut-producing farms.

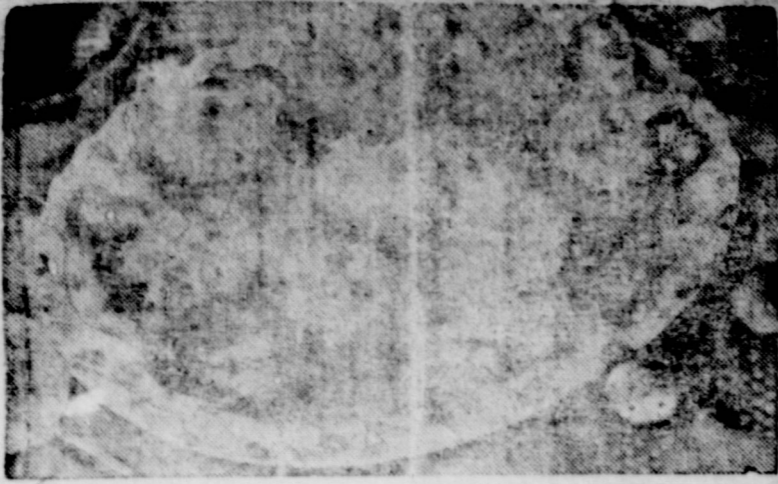

**Curried Rice and Tuna Make a Tasty and Thrifty Filling for Luscious Tomatoes**

**INGREDIENTS:**  
 8 medium sized ripe tomatoes  
 4 tablespoons minced onion  
 4 tablespoons minced green pepper  
 4 tablespoons butter or margarine

1 7-ounce can tuna fish  
 2 cups cooked rice  
 2 teaspoon curry powder  
 2 teaspoon salt  
 2 teaspoon pepper  
 1/2 cup water

**PREPARING THE FLUFFY WHITE RICE:** To make 3 liberal cups of fluffy rice, put 1 cup of uncooked rice, 2 cups of cold water and 1 teaspoon of salt into a 2 quart saucepan and bring to a vigorous boil. Turn the heat as low as possible. Cover saucepan with a lid and leave over this

low heat for 14 minutes. Do not remove lid nor stir rice while it is cooking. Turn off the heat. Use exact measurements of uncooked rice and water. Time the cooking accurately.

For real convenience and economy of time and effort, keep uncooked rice in the refrigerator in a covered container at all times. Use it for many quick, delicious and inexpensive soups, salads, casserole dishes, hot breads and desserts.

**METHOD:** Peel tomatoes easily by scalding, plunging into cold water and then peeling. Slice off stem end of tomatoes. Carefully scoop out pulp. Cook onion and green pepper in the butter or margarine until tender. Add the tuna fish, rice, curry powder, salt, pepper and water. Mix thoroughly. Fill the tomatoes with the tuna and rice mixture and bake at 350° F. about 15 minutes or until the tomatoes are tender. Serve hot. Garnish with green pepper rings if desired.

For a cool and refreshing salad, chill the tomatoes after they are stuffed and serve on salad greens. This recipe makes 8 servings of 3 cups of the curried tuna and rice mixture.

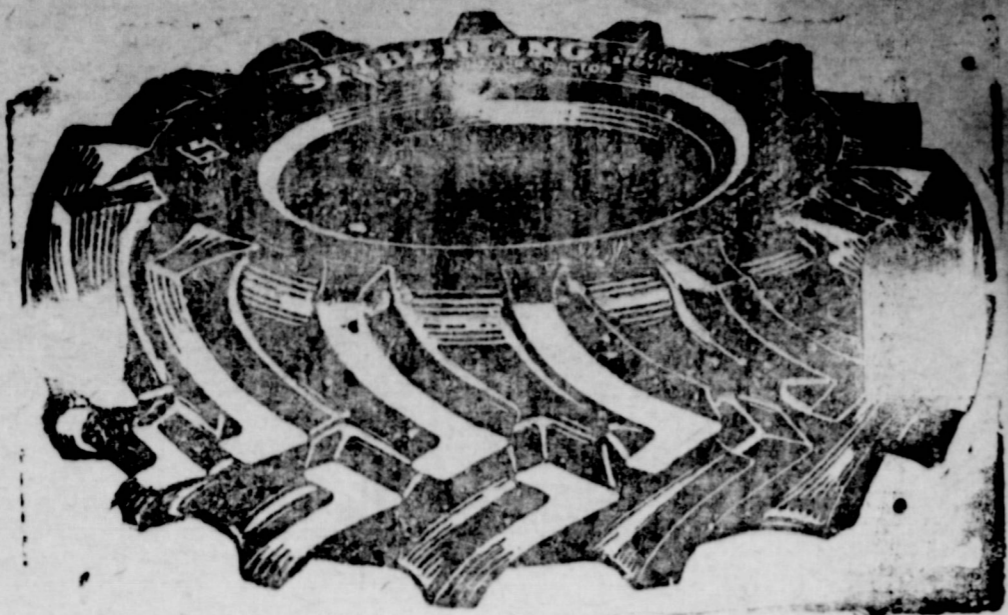

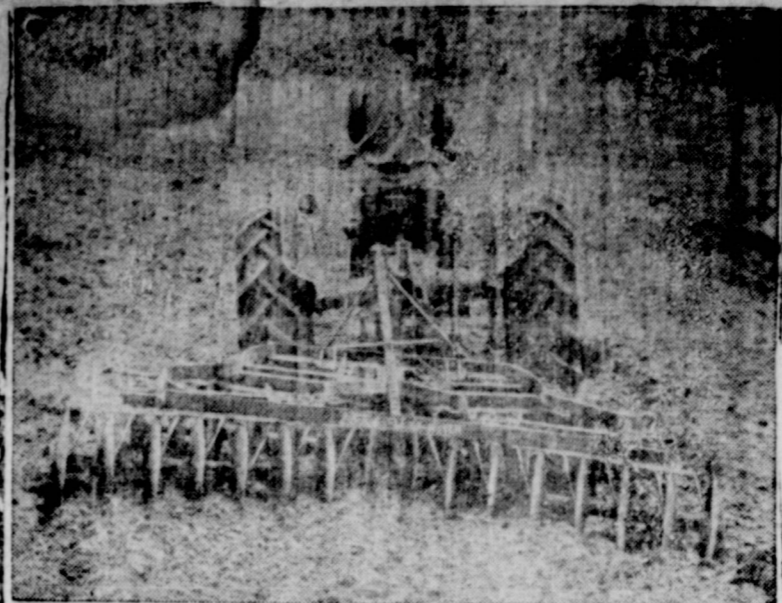
