Approximately 1,000 persons attended the annual Eastland County Livestock Show held in Eastland Saturday despite light rain, it was reported here. County FFA and 4-H club members competed for some \$1,200 in prize money in the show, sponsored by the Eastland County Livestock Raisers Association.

He also was the owner of the grand and reserve champion fine wool breeding ewes, both Rambouillets bred by H. C. Wilkinson of Ranger.
