

BLANTON DEMANDS FACTS ABOUT 36TH

Washington, Feb. 20.—Failing to receive a statement containing anything more than generalities from his inquiry to the war department on conditions in the 36th Division, Rep. Blanton of Texas last night addressed the house on the matter.

Blanton submitted a further statement from R. E. Johnson, of Burnett County who recently returned from war work overseas in which Johnson declared that the division is billeted over a territory ten or fifteen miles square and that while officers are fairly well quartered the enlisted men are sleeping in many instances in barns with eattle, and that many of them are sick and that they are generally in bad spirits.

The moral surroundings, Johnson said in his statement which Mr. Blanton inserted in the record are bad. Johnson served as a soldier in the Spanish-American war. Rep. Blanton deplored the failure of the war department to make a report on the matter and said congress has a right to get the facts and should exercise its preprogrative to get them.
