50,000 Men in Army to Be Relieved for Home Coming

Washington, April 3.—The war department today sent a cablegram to General Pershing advising him that fifty thousand men were being recruited to be used in replacing members of the U. S. army of occupation who were deserving of immediate release and return home.

The men in the army of occupation who are the most deserving, for various causes, of early release and return home, will be returned to America as soon as the men selected to relieve them can be sent to the army of occupation headquarters.

SELECTING LOS

ARROYO WELL SITE

V. V. Waite, Geologist from the State University, arrived in Ballinger Thursday at noon, and immediately afternoon left for the Los Arroyo field, accompanied by F. W. Hunter, president of the Safety First Oil & Gas Co., and others, and began the survey for the well to be drilled somewhere west of Ballinger.

Mr. Waite will make a thorough survey of the field and will select the drilling site for the Los Arroyo well. Mr. Hunter will go to Fort Worth as soon as the survey is made and place an order for material for the derrick and close the contract for drilling the well. While this company has until July first in which to begin actual drilling, they will begin earlier than that.

TUCKER WITH THE FORT WORTH NATIONAL

We are glad to note that J. Harrold Tucker has accepted a good position with the Fort Worth National Bank. Mr. Tucker was with the First National Bank when he volunteered for army service, and was offered his place when he returned home, but as seems to be the case with most of the boys returning from the army, there is something better waiting for them.

Berlin, April 3.—Foreign Minister Beba Kun, of the Hungarian Soviet government, arrived in Munich for the purpose of forming an alliance with the Hungarian, Austrian and Bavarian Soviet governments, according to unverified reports received here today.

The general strike throughout Germany is rapidly spreading. More than one hundred and fifty thousand strikers are out in Berlin, and one hundred thousand in the Ruhr district. Material law has been proclaimed in Rhineland and several have been reported killed in Stuttgart.

Milton was one of the first volunteers from Runnels County, having joined the National Guards, leaving San Angelo for Camp Bowie. He was later sent to France and transferred to Co. 37, Third Division. He was in the big drives and went over the top eight

times without a scratch. He wrote his parents that it was a miracle that he came out alive. Soon after the armistice was signed he entered the hospital for an operation for some disease of the liver. But his physical energy was not equal to the shock of the operation. He died February 5th in Base Hospital No. 8. His parents will ask the government to send his body to Miles for burial.

The father was in Ballinger today on his way to Louisiana with a shipment of stock. He is greatly broken up because his son did not live to return home after having performed so well his part in the war.

WEED BLOAT KILLING COWS

Reports coming to The Ledger tell of the loss of valuable cows from what is known as "Weed Bloat." Weeds are more numerous than usual and cows are grazing on them, and where they get too much death results, if relief from the "bloat" does not come quick. J. H. Taylor reported Thursday that eight head of cows had died in South Ballinger, and loss in other neighborhoods are being keenly felt.
