Paris, April 23.—President Wilson issued a statement this afternoon in which he flatly declared that Italy cannot have Fiume.

This leaves it up to the Italian s to carry out their threat to withdraw from the peace conference or back down on their stand and demand for possession of Fiume.

Foreign Minister Sonnino and the Italian delegation are in possession of Mr. Wilson's official statement, and it is expected that they will reply to the peace conference.

In his statement Mr. Wilson said that the Jugo-Slav countries must have Fiume as a Meterrian sea port.

Paris, April 23.—"President Wilson's statement has broken up the peace conference," said a member of the Italian delegation this afternoon

Washington, April 23 .- President Wilson's statement given out in Paris today is regarded here as an appeal to the Italian people to overthrow the reactionary Sonnio regime and send a new delegation to Paris who can deal with the peace conference.




