Huge Telescope Is About Ready

Most Powerful Instrument in World to Give Man Better Look Into Universe.

PASADENA CALIF. - The most powerful telescope in the world de-signed to give man his farthest and most comprehensive look into the universe, should be ready for its first test next summer, said Po⁻ John A. Anderson. Anderson and his associates at the California Institute of Technol-agy refused to expected to see, but their enthusism grows as each day brings nearer the completion of this giant telescope.

brings hearer the completion of this giant telescope. The telescope with its 200-inch mirror is expected to permit astron-omers to "see" twice as far into space as they do now with a 100-inch telescope. To Bring Moon Closer.

To Bring Moon closer. The instrument will embrace eight times as much space, and reflect four times the amount of light. It should bring the moon within an arm's length of earth, astro-nomically speaking. It may lead to discovery of new blocks and tars.

It may lead to discovery of new planets and stars. The optical range of this telescope, according to theory, should be about one billion light years. A light year is the distance light travels, at 186, 000 miles a second, in a year. This new range should enable astronomers to make a more aco in the universe of this earth. The project, financed by Rocketel-ter foundation, includes work here and at Mt. Palomar 125 miles to the southeast.


