MAN IS KILLED IN GIN

(Abilene Reporter)

Gus Gerhardt, a long-time resident of Abilene, was instantly killed about two o'clock Tuesday afternoon at Bradshaw in an accident at a gin where he was work

With W. S. Martin, Mr. Gerhardt was working about the automatie steam press which tramps down the cotton. The machine had become jammed in some way and Mr. Martin elimbed up on top to unstop it, while Mr. Gerhardt remained below. It is supposed that he leaned over in the press to pull out some jammed cotton, when the lever which automatically operates the press caused the heavy tamper to come down, eatch ing his head and shoulders inside the press. His death was instantaneous. Mr. Martin said he thought Mr. Gerhardt had sustained only a broken arm at first, but when he climbed down and threw the lever which brought the steam operated tramper back up, he found that the man was dead.

The body was brought to Abilene by the Laughter Undertaking Company, and prepared for burial. The funeral arrangements had not been made Wednesday at noon. but it will be conducted from the home, South 12th and Sycamore streets, sometime Thursday, by the Rev. E. T. Miller, pastor of the South Side Baptist church.
