AMERICAN LEGIONS HEROS PAYS TRIBUTE

With the large auditorium of the Methodist church filled to standing room and with quite a number turned away, the citizens of this city and surrounding country paid a tribute of honor to the soldiers who sleep on French soil, Sunday afternoon, and witnessed the presentation of French diplomas to the next of kin of those who lost their life in service in France.

It was an impressive service, and the program carried out made for a better appreciation of the service rendered by the American soldiers, and the large audience got a better understanding of the American Legion and what that organization stands for.

The meeting at this hour was held under the auspices of the American Legion, and for the purpose of presenting the French diplomas, which were sent to the local post for distribution to the next of kin of the soldiers who died in France.

J. H. Bauch, post commander of the Pat Williams' Post American Legion, presided at the meeting, and it was he who in a brief address, told of the purposes of the American Legion.

Following a scripture reading by Dr. R. T. Phillips, and prayer by Rev. Hampton, Dr. Alvin Swindell delivered the address, or sermon, and emphasized the appreciation felt in the heart of every true American for the service rendered by the American army.

Due to sickness, and various other causes, many of the relatives of deceased soldiers were not present to receive the diplomas, but under the direction of the local post American Legion, these diplomas will be mailed to the proper parties.

While the large crowd was gath-

ering, the orchestra, under the direction of C. T. Grant, rendered music, which was the occasion of much favorable comment, and the orchestra was given several places on the program.

A solo by Miss Anna Jean Sharp and a chorus by the primary pupils of the Ballinger schools were features of the musical program.

This was the first public meeting of the local post American Legion, and it was a success in every respect.

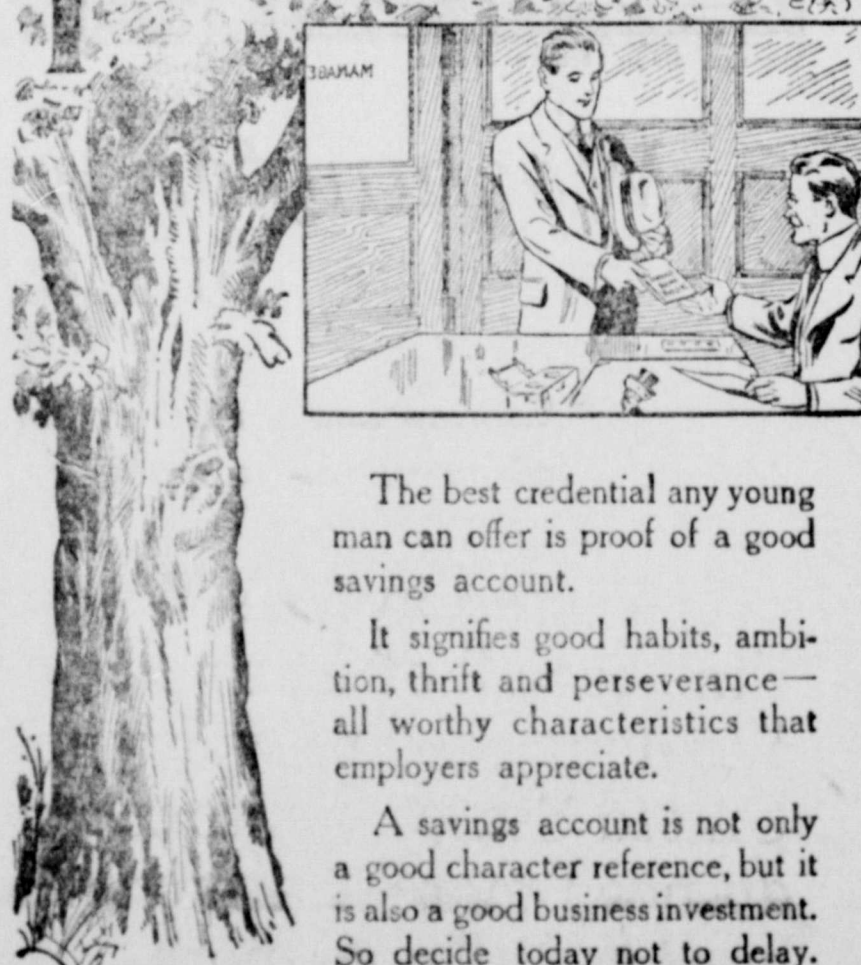

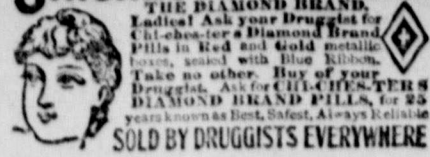

TWO NEGROES DEAD; THIRD NEGRO DYING

Jerry Smith, negro, who was out in a fight with Louis Parker in the kitchen of the Central Hotel, last Friday, died Sunday night.

Smith was slashed in the abdomen with a long bladed pocket-knife in the hands of Parker, and it was announced at the time that he would probably die. He seemed to be getting along as well as could be expected until Sunday when he became suddenly worse

and died in a few hours. Friends of the dead negro were arranging to bury him Monday, or ship his remains to his old home in some other county. They were communicating with relatives of Smith and were waiting for instructions late Monday afternoon.

Parker is in the local jail to await the action of the grand jury which convenes here on March 8. As it is only two weeks until the grand jury will investigate the case, and probably return an indictment, it is not believed that any effort will be made to get the

negro out on bond. Dennis Watts, negro, is dead at Winters, and Ernest Hall, another negro, is dying, as the result of a shooting scrape between the two negroes, Saturday night.

The shooting took place on the farm of Al Griffin, seven miles north of Winters about eight o'clock Saturday night, the trouble resulting in a claim of \$5.75 which one of the negroes claimed the other owed him.

According to information received at Ballinger, Watts shot Hall through the stomach twice with a thirty-eight pistol. Hall then went after Watts with a shot gun, trying to break in the house where Watts had fled after shooting Hall. Failing to break in the door Hall pulled an old sack that was tacked over one of the windows, off, and sticking a shot-gun through the window, shot Watts through the heart.

Reports received from Winters late Monday afternoon stated that Hall would die in a short time, and thereby the courts of the county would save the expense of sending him to the pen.

While two or three thousand negroes were shipped in here last fall to pick cotton, and spent several months here, this is the first serious trouble to occur in the county. Most of the negroes have returned to their home, in South and East Texas, but many have accepted work here to help make another crop.

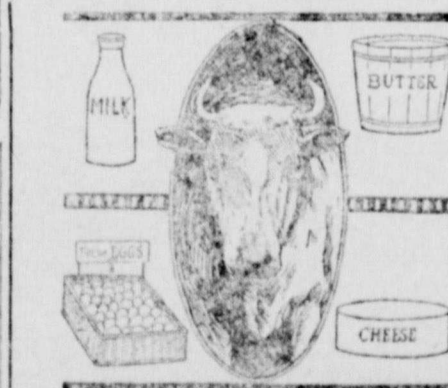
