Delicate fabrics, such as organ-dy and fine voiles, can be restored to their original crispness with gelatin. To do this, dissolve a tea-spoon of plain gelatin in a quart of boiling water. Strain the solu-tion and use as you would boiled starch.

Get more servings from your meat roast by cooking slowly at a low temperature.

Add a little salt when cooking dried fruits and it will help bring out the fruit's natural sweetness.
