For Possible Future Use PITTSBURGH.—The instruments of war, temporarily in disuse, are not going to be beaten into plough-shares. Rather, they will be scientifically sealed in specially built containers and treated by a new process that will prevent corrosion, decay or de-terioration.

# AROUND THE

Place a rubber tip such as used on a crutch on the end of your broom handle and it will not slip when stood broom end up.

One-foot squares of burlap may be folded into pads which work very well as scouring pads. Apply scouring powder. After using, rinse well, and the pads will last a long time.

Instead of using a trowel to work around the roots of small seed-lings, try using an apple corer. The sharp point and small size of the corer will not be likely to injure the delicate roots.
