

This number of rabbits repre sents only a small part of the rabbits slaughtered in the county during last week. A rabbit drive was held somewhere in the county almost every day last week, and the good work is in progress this week. All the rabbits killed are not sealped, many of the hunters not taking time to make the three cents per head the county is offering for

The small bounty, if saved, will help to pay the cost of killing the rabbits, but the greatest results will be in saving to crops when planting time comes. Rabbits are thick in some localities and will destroy crops if the farmers do not guard against their depredations by destroying
