The film, he reported, can be sewed directly to remnants of a damaged coating of the brain, and provides a covering until nature regenerates a protective membrane of so far as he knew, there is no other dural substitute now available which produces as little reaction as fibrin film, and no other which adapts its self so readily to any contour of the brain.
