TEXAN GIVES ACCOUNT HIS THRILLING ESCAPE THROWS ACID HOWDEN, England, Aug. 25.
-Norman Walker, of Commerce,
Texas, sole Amerioan survivor of
the crew of the ZR-2, today gave
to the Associated Press the first
circumstantial account of the dis-
aster which destroyed the great
super dirigible late yesterday as
it was completing what prom-
ised to be a most successful trial
trip. Only five were saved from
the ghastly tragedy, and accord-
ing to Walker his escape was a
most miraculons one.
He said that finding that all
the parachutes had been taken by the British members of the
crew, he and three Englishmen climbed on the fabric of the ship
forward of the tail cup after the ship had broken into balves. Ho held to his position until shortly
