## THE PEOPLE OF TEXAS MUST DECIDE THE FATE OF TEXAS RAILROADS

- THE WELPARE of Texas and Texans has gone and will always go hand in hand with the wolfare of Texas railroads. Their dependeney mpen each other is absoluta.
In 1929 Texas railroads gave employment to 82,956 employes, to whom thoy paid annually $\$ 126,674,543$ in salaries and wages. In 1850 this nambor decreased to 70,739 while the payroll deelined to $\$ 100,802,226$. In 1981 the number of employes fell to M,048 and the payroll to 889,505,918.

This represents a decresse of more than $\$ 87,000,000$ in purchasing power in Texas communitics. There has been a corresponding decrease in purchace of materials and supplies by Texas, railroads. The ablity to have main tained railroad payrolle and purchaces would have been a very important factor in overcoming the present trying economic condition.

The decline in railroad payrolls and parchases is due only in part to ecenomic conditions. The revenues of the railroads have been affected not only by business conditions but to a very large extent by lose of traffic to truck and buses using the public highways in competition with the railroads.

- The time has come shom the people of Texas must decide whether the traffic of this state can best be carried by the rellroade, meing facilities which they built and maintain at their own exponce, or by trwelo and broces using the highonge bilt and maintained at the taxpayers' expence.
