INDIAN PROBE **KEPT SECRET**

(By Associated Press) OKLAHOMA CITY, March 14. -George Short, state's attorney general of Oklahoma, issued a flat denial today that his office had within the last few days conducted an investigation into the deaths of several Osage Indians at Pawhuska.

PAWHUSKA, Okla., March 14. -Operations of the court of inquiry, which for two days is understood to have been investigating the deaths of a number of Indians in Osage county in 1922, were still being kept secret today.

The inquiry is being conducted under the direction of Berry King, assistant state's attorney. The court opened Thursday, and after one day's hearing here, King and his associates disappeared, and their whereabouts are being kept secret.


