Ballinger's prospects for an oil field were brighter than ever Saturday when the Sillix et al McMillan No. 1, five miles north of Ballinger, Jomingo Diaz survey No. 532, blew itself in at 5:00 o'clock Saturday morning at a depth of 2,545 feet.

The well, flowing in heads at 30 minute intervals, is believed to be capable of making between 750 and 1,000 barrels daily when the bit is sent into the sand.
