## Creative Woman

Topics to be presented on "The Creative Woman" show on March 6 and 10 include wardrobe planning for Spring/Summer and salads.

Pris Selpeter, Regional Fashion Coordinator for Casual Corner in Arlington, Texas will discuss wardrobe planning and show how the concept of "2+2+5=30" works for Spring and Summer. The garments will be modeled by Rochelle Clark, manager of the Lubbock Casual Corner store. Fabrics, colors, accessories and textures will be discussed also.

Marilyn Dompe is the Public Relations Manager for the California Iceberg Lettuce Commission in Monterey, California and she will present information on the California Health Club salad and will show several different salads, talk about nutritive value of lettuce, alone and with other vegetables combined in the salad, and do a comparison of different types of salads.

On March 8 and 11, the topics will be barbecue basics and an interesting demonstration on cutting up chickens. Christy Kirk, home economist and spokesperson with the Reynolds Metals Co. in Los Angeles will talk about how to prepare the barbecue grill for cooking, equipment to use for grilling, some safety tips, and explain the two types of barbecuing. She will also demonstrate how to properly wrap food to be cooked on the grill and discuss some of the different types of foods that can be grilled - such as appetizers, desserts, as well as the typical ones such as meats or kabobs.

Viewers will enjoy his first demonstration where he completely cuts up a fryer in less than 15 seconds. He follows this with a "slow motion" demonstration showing exactly where and how to cut the chicken. He will also show how to de-bone the chicken breasts for certain recipes. He is a very entertaining guest.


