|  | Several amendments were add- do the proposed bill, including one that would bar a student from attending a state-financed or assisted school for two years following three convictions for violation of the act. If a student were convicted twice under the act, he could not receive any state loans. Another amendment assures students taking part in demonstrations the right to peaceful protest. A trespass bill by Rep. Menton Murray of Harlingen is awaiting action. This bill would make it unlawful for anyone "with a malicious and mischeievous intent" to trespass on the property of someone else, including campuses. It now is in the House Committee on Criminal Jurisprudence. <br> Other bills were filed dealing with law enforcement. <br> Senate Youth Affairs Committee voted to report favorably to provide fairer hearings on juvenile offenders, which could include some of the demonstrators - especially at high sehools. <br> One of the proposals would require the court to appoint an attorney to represent a juvenile of- fender, if the parents cannot afford one. If the judge determines that the parents can afford an attorney, he can require that they get one. get one. |  |
