The annual encampment of 4-H Club girls and Home Demonstration Club women will be held Tuesday, August 24, at the Country Club.

Agricultural Adjustment Administration offices over the state of Texas have reduced personnel and the local AAA office now has only two clerks, Mrs. Jean Reeder and Miss Juanita Boman.

On account of the drouth, the City water supply is being reduced to such an extent that the City Council feels that it is necessary to curtail the use of water until the supply is replenished. The minimum will be lowered from 4,000 to 2,500 gallons per month and the excess will be raised to \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons.
