30 Years Ago in The News

News items below were taken from the Thursday, September 28, 1944, issue of The Foard County News:

Sgt. Albert M. (Merl) Sandlin, son of Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Sandlin of the Vivian community, has been reported missing in action since Sept. 12 over Germany, according to a telegram received by his parents Monday from the adjutant general in Washington, D.C.

Seven Foard County men left Sunday for Dallas to report for induction into the armed forces. They were Clois L. Orr, Clinton L. McLain, John H. Traweck, Everett Crisp, William L. Gray, Cecil L. Davidson and William G. Erwin.

Pvt. Wilburn C. Pierce, son of Mr. and Mrs. G. F. Pierce of the Vivian community, was killed in a glider accident in New Guinea on Sept. 19, according to a telegram received Monday by his parents from the Secretary of War in Washington, D.C.

Seven Foard County farmers were among some 210 farmer delegates at Paducah who met with state and national officials to formulate a program for setting a ceiling on cotton picking and pulling.
