State Constitution Authorizing the Levy of a Tax*

Joint Resolution amending Sectlon 9, of Article 8, of the Con stitution of the state of Texas providing for the lerying of a
tax of not exceeding fifteen cents on the one hundred dolcents on tars valuation to pay jurors Section 1. Be it resolved by Texas: That Section 9 , of Ar. tiole 8, of the Constitution of the State of Texas, be so amended as to here after read as follows.
Section 9. The State tax on property, exciusive of the tax and of the taxes provided for the benefitof the public free schools, shall never exceed thirtyafive
cents on the one hundred dollars valuation, and no county. city or town shall levy more than twen-y-five cents for city or connty
purposes, and not exceeding fifteen cents for road and bridges, pay jurors, on the one hundred dollars valuation, except for the payment of debts incurred prior to the adoption of the amendment September 25th, 1888, and ings, streets, sewers, water worss and other permanent improvecents on the one hundred Collars valuation, in any one year, and except as is in this Constitution otherwise provided; and the Leg, slature may also authorze an
dditicnal annual ad valorem tax to be levied and collected for the further maintenance of the public roads, provided that a majorpaying voters of the county voting at an election to be held for that purpose shall vote such tax, ne hundred diteen cents on the he property subject to taxation in such county.
