## Geology．

The geelogical mystery of Tex as is the Llano Estacado or Stak－ od Plains，which is in reality a great，stoen land．Its elevatzd sur－ face ombraces fifty thousand sq miles，almost perfectly smooth unbroken by trees and carpeted with deep，rich grasses upon which millions of herds find their existence the year round．
Two streams，the Canadian and the Pecos flow around it，and and faet below the level．The wall of this vast table liland can

be seen for a distance of 50 miles． The soil is rich and productive There is a porous sediment soil，sand，gravel and salt in hor sointal layers to a depth of two hundred fit．then beneath a great floor of sands，clays and granites，
