AN ORDINANCE

Regulating traffic and travel on the streets, alleys, roads and highways in the city of Goldthwaite, estab. ishing rules of the road, prescribing conditions upon which gaid streets, alleys, roads and highways may be used by vehicles, providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith, and declaring an emer-

Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Goldthwaite, Texas: Sec. 1. All automobiles and other v hicles, except when passing another going in the sam direction, shall keep to the right and as near the right hand curb as possible.

A vehicle meeting another shall pass to the right. A vehicle overtaking another shall pass to the Advance Buying enables left, and not pull over or turn back


