The Stop-Look-and Listen sign means what it says. Stoplook both ways-and always listen. If a train is just clearing the crossing, wait-don't hurry across, there may be a hidden train coming from the opposite direction. And when you do cross, keep going. Don't shift gears on the tracks, you may stall.

Take the few extra'seconds needed, to assure a safe crossing. Don't let $X$ mark the spot where you failed to be careful.
