 Wednesday, when settled onthe Texas Highway Commission, meeting in Austin,

y imposed. The bill, if enorced would have meant hat farm equipment own-
ers would have to purchase an annual $\$ 480$ per vehicle permit to dive ther any public road. This would have included farm to mar ket and county roads.
Highway commission maintained commission was not intended to exclu-
de the incidental highways by farm equipent, to begin with.
Prior to June 19 , Texas laws had an exemption hengways for transportation of ag implements at a disance of not more than 50 carry out agricultural oper-
ations. However, effective June 19, it was made un-
lawful for any vehicle to perate on a public highWay in Texas if the to
