Postmaster Makes Final Appeal To "Mail Early" For Christmas

Postmaster Lucile Fairman had her annual Christmas "present" ready today for her patrons and, to nobody's surprise, it was her perennial suggestion: "Mail Early."

"Christmas shopping and mailing is, for most people, one of the heaviest chores at Christmas," Mrs. Fairman said.

"Virtually all Christmas mailing can be disposed of now by observing the following five suggestions," Postmaster Fairman explained.

1. Do your shopping for your Christmas gifts NOW.
2. Check and revise mailing list for cards and presents.
3. Package and mail Christmas parcels promptly. Don't worry about being too early—just mark them "Do Not Open Until Christmas."
4. Buy Christmas cards now and address them right away, separating them into out-of-town and local bundles. Mail them immediately with ZIP Codes on them and you've got it made, except perhaps for that last-minute card you forgot to send to Aunt Minnie.
5. Buy plenty of stamps now while the post office windows are uncrowded.

For Christmas cards, the Postmaster recommends use of five cent stamp which insures first-class mail treatment—meaning the card may contain personal messages and may be forwarded or returned free of extra charge.

Incidentally, to speed Christmas card handling, letter carriers and post offices will have free supplies available of "local" and "out-of-town" bands for

Christmas cards. If you will use these to separate your local and out-of-town cards, it will expedite delivery and assist your post office.

In most areas, postal patrons will find that a supply of these will be left in their mail box, or they may be had from carriers or local post offices for the asking.

And—just as an additional peace-of-mind safeguard about parcels this Christmas—the Postmaster urges you to insure them.

She noted that—despite the Department's efforts over many years to promote good packaging and addressing—the Postal Service each year has been unable to deliver or return about half a million parcels, including many lost because of poor packaging or incorrect addressing.

The Postmaster emphasized that ZIP Code can also help insure against loss due to poor addressing for letters and parcels. The five-digit ZIP code identifies one specific area. No other area has that same ZIP Code number. Therefore, Mrs. Fairman explained—in view of the great number of opportunities for error that arise from the fact that there are many streets and cities with similar names the ZIP Code is a real asset for Christmas mail, as well as for regular mailing.

"For example, if a letter is addressed to 'Mineaola' and the state is left out or is illegible we can tell from the ZIP Code, if used, whether it goes to Mineola, Iowa, New York, Texas or Missouri, each of which have a city by that name," Mrs. Fairman said.

Funeral services for Miss Mary Alice Fisher, a retired civil service worker in the U.S. Department of Commerce, were held Wednesday afternoon, December 18, at 2:00 o'clock, in the First Baptist Church of Mullin. Services were conducted by Rev. Ellis E. Eppf of Lohn, assisted by Rev. Chester Sylvester, pastor of the First Baptist Church of Mullin. Miss Fisher was born January 2, 1886 in Mullin and passed away in Brownwood Memorial Hospital, Monday, December 16. For many years she lived in Washington and Chicago while employed with the Department of Commerce, then returned to Mullin when she retired in 1956.

Since her return to Mullin much of her time had been spent in transcribing books into Braille for use by blind students in the state. Last month she was awarded a pin depicting membership in the "Ten Thousand Club" for persons who had transcribed more than 10,000 pages in Braille.

Survivors are her brother, Sam J. Fisher of Brownwood; a number of nieces, nephews, and a host of friends.
