[^0]:    The administration of Clyde Garrett as County Judge has been arked care, fovethought and efficient management of such mat ters as lawfully come under the supervision of that office.

    It is notable that the county funds did not suffer any loss when the county depository closed its doors, with some $\$ 265,000$ of the county and school funds on deposit. These funds were protected by securities which the bank by agreement pledged the county. The careful watchfulness of Clyde Garrett over this one phase of the county's business was largely responsible for the fact that neither he county nor any school district will lose any money.

    On occation of the closing of a former county depository, the county's funds suffered a loss of $\$ 355,587.38$, which is mo doubt partly responsible for its financial stringency today.
