The bank here closed during an epidemic of bank failures
that swept this and other states and which included banks
in a number of other towns in this section, few, if any of
them, better towns than Eastland. In nearly all of these
towns, however, new banks have been organized and most of
them have been doing a profitable business for almost a year,
while Eastland still leans on its neighboring towns for bank-
ing accomodations.
The absence of banking facilities in Eastland retards the
progress of virtually all businesses and thereby retards the
growth and development of the town and the surrounding
trade territory. Not only do people in business in the town
suffer, commercially speaking, but the people of the rural
communities likewise suffer. It is imperative, therefore,
that we have a bank if we are to hope to compete with ihe
other towns of this section.
To say that a bank in Eastland would not pay and that,
there is no one to finance and operate one, is absurd. It is
not the lack of capital nor the lack of experienced and trust-
worthy bankers who are willing to engage in the banking
business here that we are still without a bank, but, in our
opinion, it is the lack of sufficient co-operation from our own
people.
If the citizens of Eastland will unite in an effort to get a
