For decades, petty rules, silly laws and frivolous lawsuits
held no power over C.S. He was credited with cultivating such valued lessons as to know when to come in out of the rain, working for a living, and that life inn't always fair. Common Sense lived by simple, sound financial policies
(don't spend more than you earn) and reliable parenting strategies (the adults are in charge, not the kids). A vetern of the Industrial Revolution, the Great Depression,
and the Technological Revolution, C.S. survived cultural and educational trends including body piercing, whole language,
"new math" and the "It's not MY iob" mentality But his health declined when he became infected with the "It takes a village to raise a child" virus. In recent times his
waning strength proved no match for the ravages of waning strength proved no match for the ravages of
overbearing federal regulation.
He watched in pain as good people became ruled by self-
serving lawyers and "enlightened" government auditors. His health rapidly deteriorated when schools endlessly implemented zero tolerance policies, reports of six-y ar-old
